Dear Friend of HACODEFU,

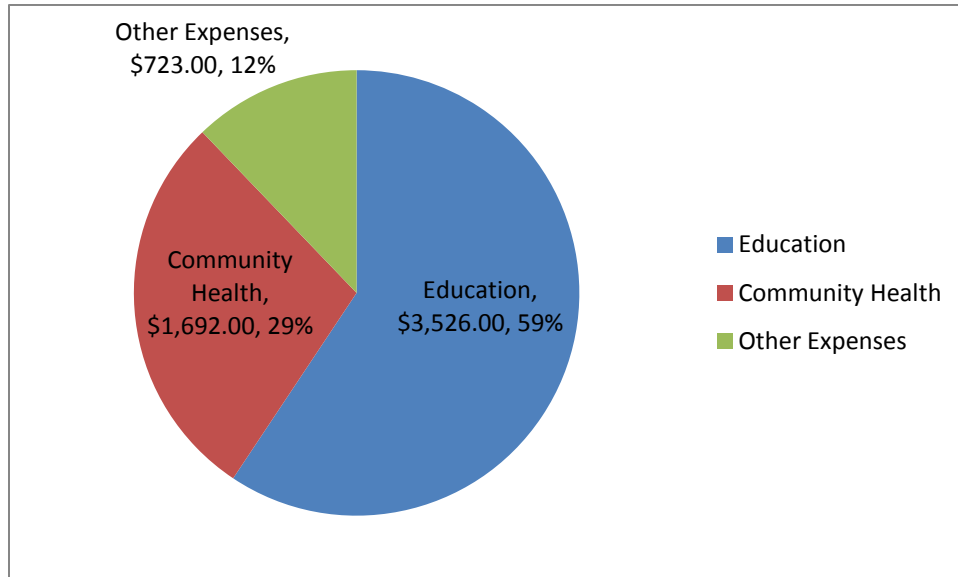
On behalf of HACODEFU, I kindly take this opportunity to thank you for your continued support of our initiatives in 2012. Together we were able to support education and health programs in Hamisi. Below are some of our achievements in 2012.

1. We awarded scholarships to thirteen (13) students in high schools and one (1) student at Moi University.
2. We assisted the family of one needy child in settling part of the child's Leukemia treatment hospital bill.
3. The construction of Mercy Academy, which had been ongoing since 2010, was finally completed.

Finances:

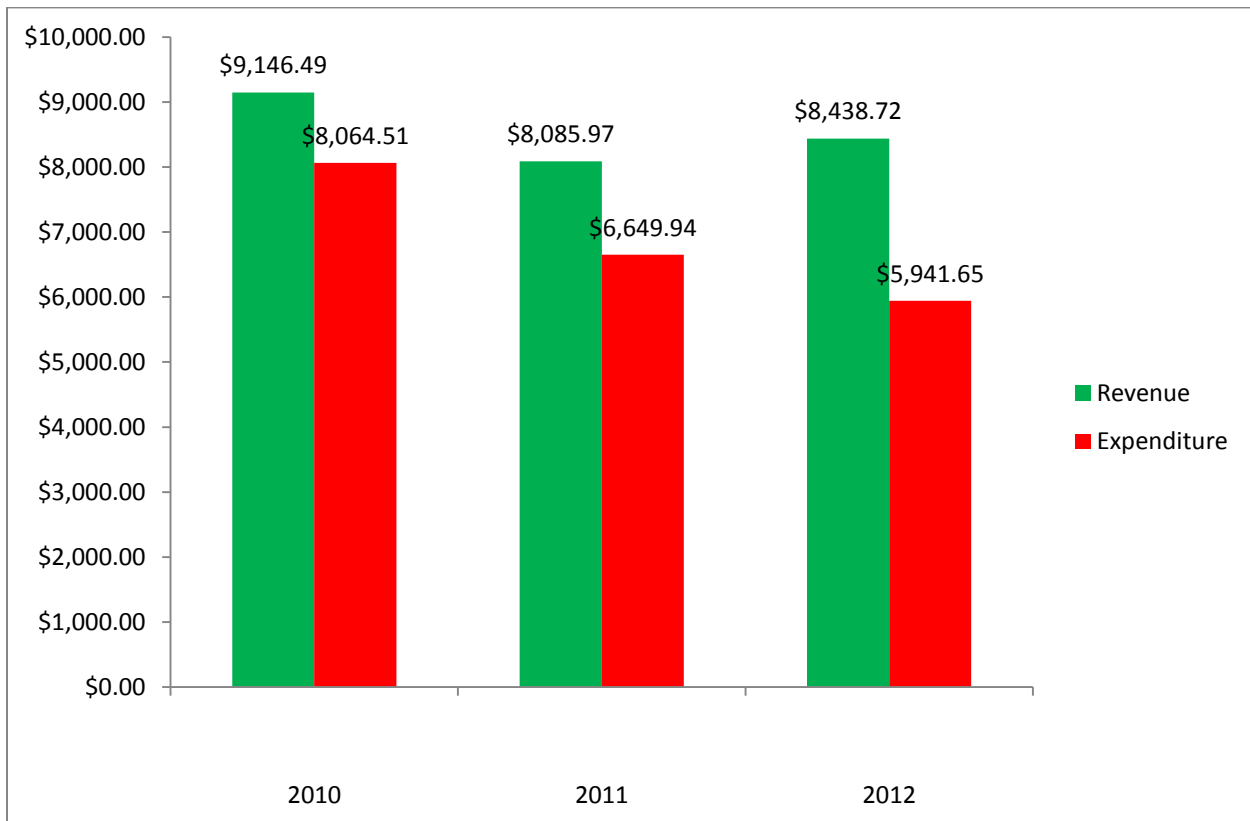
HACODEFU received a total of **\$8,438** in 2012. A total of **\$5,941** was spent and the balance, **\$2,497**, was carried forward to the 2013 fiscal year. Figure 1 below shows a summary of the 2012 expenditure.

Projects:

A: Education

I) Improvements in Schools

Mercy Academy project has been an existing project since 2010. We finally completed the construction of the school building. The completed Mercy Academy school building was officially opened on December 23rd 2012.

At least eight (8) classrooms at Cheptech Primary School had been condemned by Kenya government building inspectors. We contributed some funds towards the efforts to build new classrooms in place of those condemned.

One laptop computer was donated to Mahanga Primary School.

II) Scholarships

Scholarships were awarded to 14 students -13 in high schools and one in Moi University <http://www.mu.ac.ke/en/>. The 13 high school students were distributed in seven (7) different schools (Muhudu, St. John Cheptechi, Nyang'ori, Imusutsu, Keveye Girls, Gisambahi, and Forestal secondary schools).

B: Community Health:

The family of one needy child was assisted in settling part of the child's Leukemia treatment bill at Moi Teaching and Referral Hospital <http://www.mtrh.or.ke/>

Plans for 2013:

The year 2012 marked our third consecutive productive year for our organization. With your unwavering support, we hope to continue to improve education and health of the residents of Hamisi district in 2013 and the years to come.
